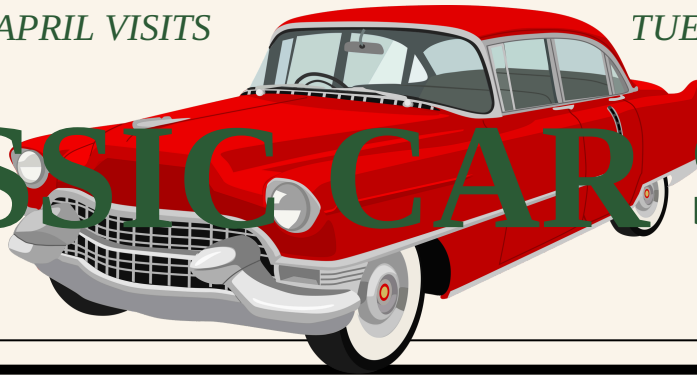
Fashion Show

Cheryl: "I loved the cars and hope that one day I can own the Batmobile!"

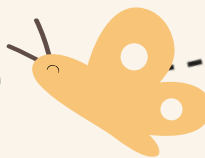
MU DANCE TEAM VISIT
